SESSION

The current contract between the church and Rev. Dr. David Hill runs until the end of April 2024. Session voted to extend this contract for another year, with the financial details changed to conform to the approved budget, but no change in the scope of work. This contract has been sent to the Presbytery for ratification by the Vitality in Ministry Committee.

The Christian Education Committee will resume the Sunday School program beginning on the second Sunday of March. This will be a "one room" Sunday School, with a range of age groups learning together.

Session voted to amend the Standing Rules by making the Feeding the Hungry program a subcommittee of the Mission Committee. At the same time administrative changes were made by deleting responsibilities related to the Children's Center from the Building and Grounds and Stewardship and Finance Committees. Since the church no longer owns this property, we have no responsibility for repairs to the facility, the payment of property taxes, and similar duties.
